An English **Scrabble set** has 100 tiles. A German set has 102, of which two have no letters.

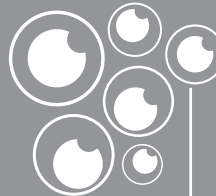
100 Men and a Girl
